



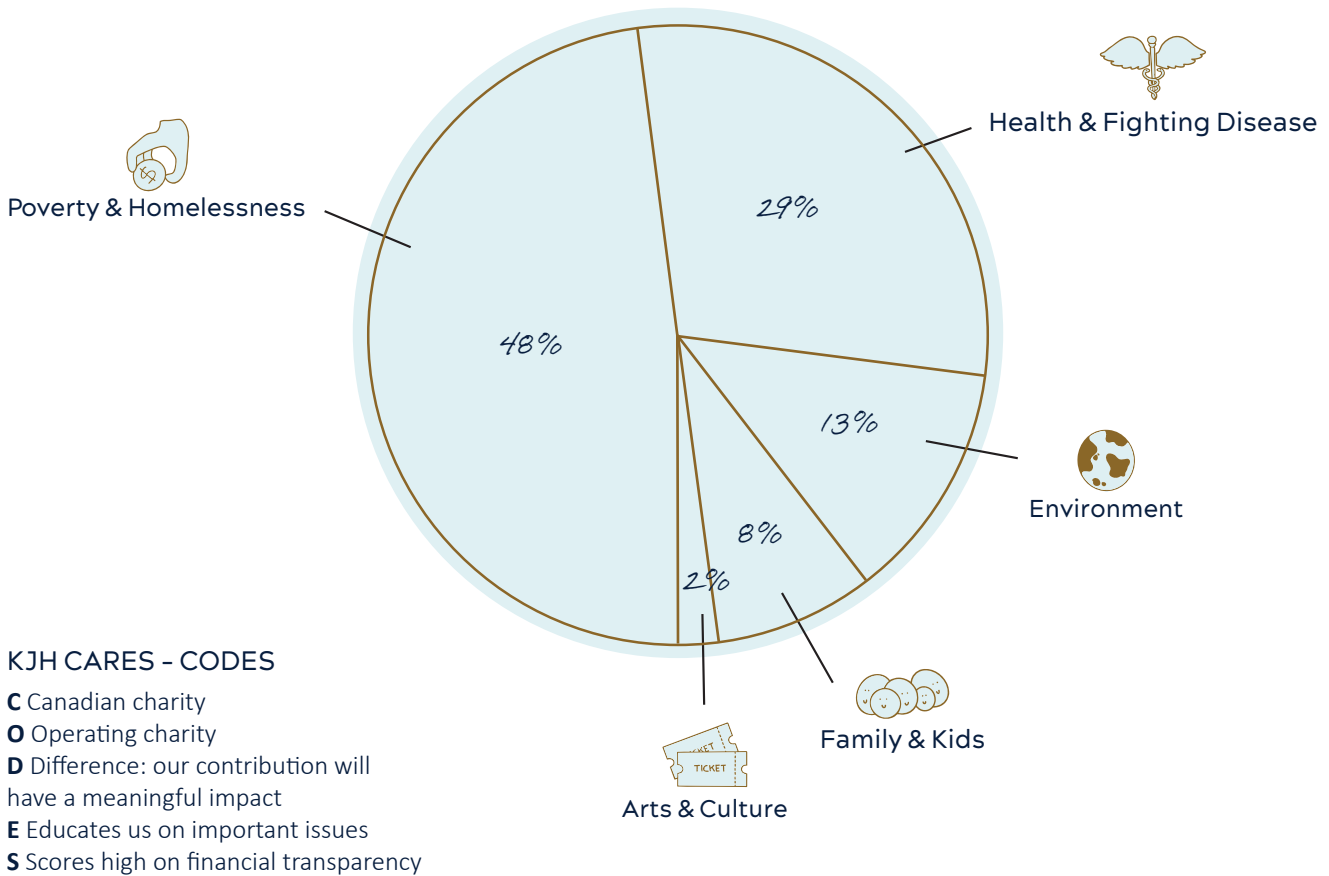

Daily Bread Food Bank

Weston Downs Food Drive - Vaughan Food Bank



Led by KJH's Christine Fulsang, the 7th Weston Downs Food Drive once again provided exceptional support to the Vaughan Food Bank. With KJH Cares sponsoring donation bags and matching t-shirts, the 2025 drive rallied local residents, volunteers, and community partners to collect a significant volume of non-perishable food and donations during a period of heightened need. This year, 14 high school students delivered red donation bags to over 2,000 homes, and 65 volunteers, including 37 students and two York Region Police Crime Prevention Officers, participated in collection day. Volunteers gathered 41 melon boxes, or about 30,750 lbs of food, and collected over \$7,200 in donations. KJH Cares was proud to support this community-driven initiative. 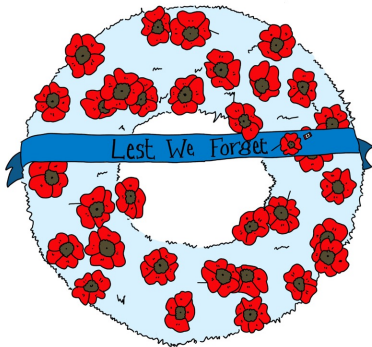
Princess Margaret Cancer Foundation's Walk to Conquer Cancer

Lions Foundation Dog Guides

Christine Fulsang and her family once again volunteered as a foster family with the Lions Foundation of Canada Dog Guides (LFDG). LFDG empowers Canadians with disabilities by training and matching dogs across seven specialized programs, including Canine Vision, Hearing, Service, Seizure Response, Autism Assistance, Diabetes Alert, and Facility Support.

The Fulsang family's first foster, Zena, joined them in March 2024 and began Diabetes Alert training in June 2025. Snoopy joined in June 2025 and was recalled that October to begin Autism Assistance training. Their newest foster, Peach, arrived in July 2025 and has just started her journey. The family has also puppy-sat for other fosters, helping socialize young dogs and teach them house manners and obedience in preparation for formal Dog Guide training. KJH Cares is delighted to donate to and support LFDG, knowing these future service dogs are so well cared for and making a lasting difference in people's lives.
